2026–2027 Orchestra Class Fee

The annual orchestra class fee is \$350 per student. These funds directly support the educational experiences and opportunities provided throughout the school year.

Payment Options

Pay in Full: \$350 by October 1, 2026 (all class fees must be complete by January 8, 2027)

Or five installments of \$70 each:

Installment	Due Date
1st Payment - \$70	August 22, 2026
2nd Payment - \$70	September 18, 2026
3rd Payment - \$70	October 16, 2026
4th Payment - \$70	November 13, 2026
Final Payment - \$70	December 11, 2026

Separate participation fees may apply for activities such as All-County, Solo & Ensemble, All-State Orchestra, trip shirts, and student travel opportunities.
